Begin the day by paying a visit to the magnificent Sultan Grand Mosque, which features exquisite artwork and stained tiles. The garden farms with coconut, banana, papaya, and vegetable plantations will be the next stop. Following that, we'll go to Al Baleed, a UNESCO World Heritage site, and the Museum of the Frankincense Land. It displays the region's historical and archaeological heritage, as well as its exceptional maritime tradition. Following our visit to the historical site, we proceed to the Al Haffa Souq best place to buy Frankincense and incense and a photo stop at Al Husn Palace. The Souq also sells a wide range of products such as gold and silver jewelry, textiles, clothing, and other traditional artifacts.

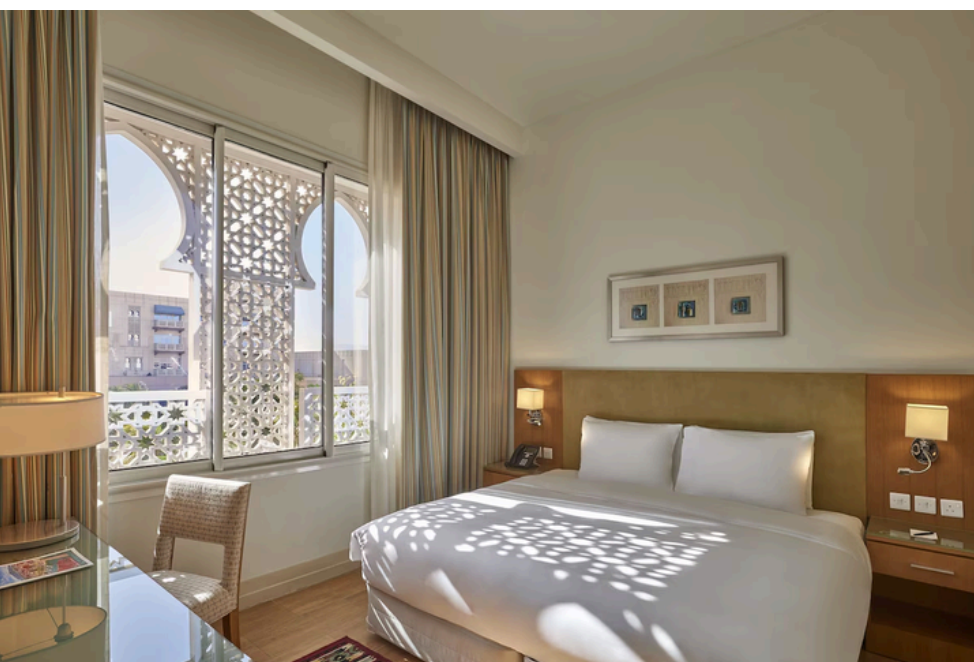

Next, explore Khor Rori Creek, home to the ruins of Sumhuran, a key site in the frankincense trade. Continue to Ain Garziz spring, then stop for photos at Nabi Ayoub with beautiful landscapes. End the day at Al Mughsail Beach, known for its blowholes, where seawater erupts like a geyser from the cliffs.
